CITY-COUNTY FISCAL ORDINANCE NO. 13, 2019 Proposal No. 258, 2019

A FISCAL ORDINANCE amending the City-County Annual Budget for 2019 (City-County Fiscal Ordinance No. 22, 2018) by additional appropriations of Nine Hundred Thousand dollars (\$900,000).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY-COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS AND OF MARION COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. To provide for expenditures the necessity for which has arisen since its adoption, the City-County Annual Budget for 2019 is hereby amended by the fund and character increase hereinafter stated for purposes of the Office of Public Health and Safety.

SECTION 2. The Office of Public Health and Safety, requests an additional appropriation in the amount of Nine Hundred Thousand dollars (\$900,000), \$120,000 in Character 1 for two peace keepers focused on juvenile referrals and \$780,000 in Character 3 for various food assistance programs to include but not limited to expansion of home delivery service for groceries, Lyft Pilot support, Food Champions Program, Mobile Food Markets, and marketing for the Food Compass App, as well as, technical assistance for continued neighborhood outreach:

SECTION 3. In support of the additional appropriation provided in Section 2, revenue totaling Nine Hundred Thousand dollars (\$900,000) collected from the State of Indiana are to be transferred from the City Rainy Day Subfund to the Consolidated County General Subfund.

SECTION 4. Upon approval of this and other pending proposals, the following unappropriated fund balances are projected to remain at the end of 2019:
